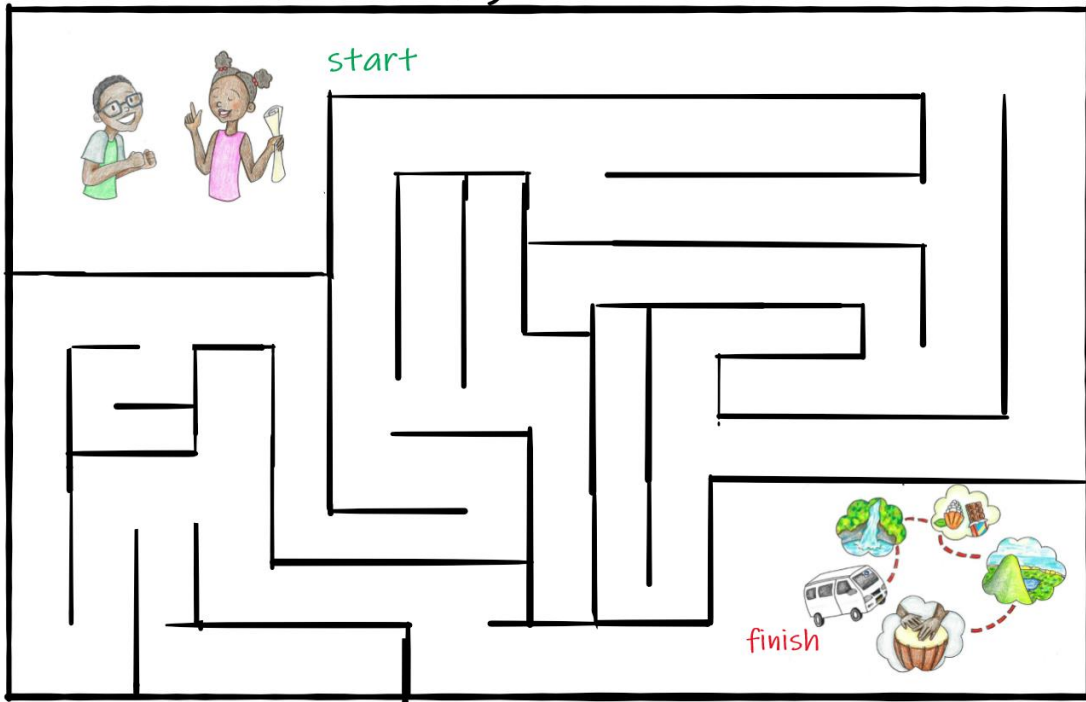

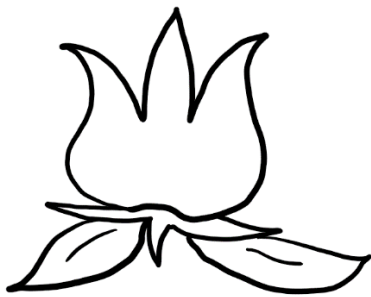

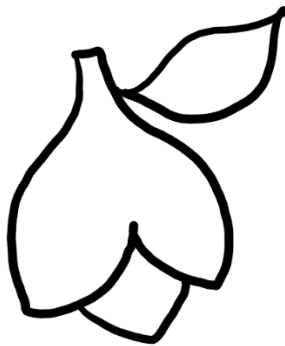

Geography

- Where is the Caribbean?
- What is the Caribbean like?
- What languages are spoken in the Caribbean?
- Where is Grenada?
- What language is spoken in Grenada?
- Which is the Northern Parish of Grenada?
- What are the “N”, “S”, “E”, and “W” letters on a map? What do they mean?
- Where is a place that you would like to visit?
